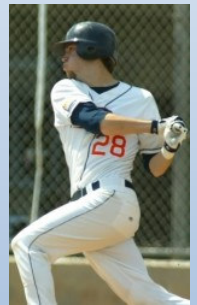

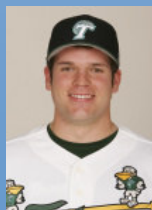


Senators Go Deep on First Day of MLB Draft

Many former Vienna Senators were selected on the first day of the MLB Draft. In fact the former Senators accounted for almost 2% of the total selections on the first day. The Senators showed the high caliber of talent they have assembled through the years with picks in the first three rounds, also former Senators were selected often as well as he final tally on the first 18 rounds stands at 10. Manny Burris became the 4th former Senator selected in the first round as he was taken in the supplemental phase with the 33rd overall pick by the Giants. Burris's 2003 teammate Mark Hamilton followed him in the 2nd round supplemental phase with St. Louis making him the 76th pick overall. Burris's 2004 teammate Chad Tracy made it three of a kind as he was selected by Texas in the third round as the 88th overall pick. .
